Cornwall Wildlife Trust and Mounts Bay Harriers have organised a 7.5 mile multi-terrain race to help raise funds for Cornwall's special wildlife and wild places.

This is happening in your area, so we'd like to let you know the details.

We apologise if the extra cars and runners on the roads will cause you any inconvenience on the day. We are expecting approximately 350 runners.

Date and time: Sunday, 1 December 2019 – race starts at 10am
All runners are expected to finish by 12 noon

The route: The route starts at Penwith College and passes through the villages of Heamoor and Madron. The finish is at the Coombe Lane entrance to Penwith College.
The race will be fully sign-posted on the day.

If you are driving in the area on the Sunday morning please be aware of runners and race marshals on the roads at this time and take extra care.

All roads will remain open without any diversions but there may be some delays.
