Training Courses

The **Penwith Landscape Partnership** has a number of free training courses for volunteers coming up.

Wednesday 10th April

Outdoor Emergency First Aid for Volunteers

The Knut at the Plen An Gwari, St Just 9am - 5.00pm

This session is designed to meet the needs of outdoor workers and volunteers, and those participating will receive an Outdoors First Aid Emergency Action qualification which is externally regulated. And as the name would suggest, the session includes outdoor training at the stunning Cape Cornwall.



Wednesday 15th May and Sunday 9th June

Small Pearl Bordered Fritillary Butterfly Identification and Recording workshop

St Just and Zennor, 9.30am - 4.30pm

This workshop will give volunteers the ability to identify and record new colonies of this increasingly rare butterfly species within Penwith, with an indoor session in the morning and outdoor in the afternoon. Informed by a better knowledge of the geographical location of the species within Penwith, we can then undertake targeted conservation work. This workshop is being run by Kernow Ecology on our behalf and will be held twice, in St Just at the Knut in the Plen An Gwari on 15th May, and repeated at Zennor Village Hall on 9th June.

Bog Dragonfly Identification and Recording

The Knut at the Plen An Gwari, St Just 9am - 4.30pm both days

This 2 day workshop (with an indoor session on the 26th and outdoor on the 27th) will train volunteers to identify and record the presence of the small red damselfly, and a handful of other dragonfly and damselflies in Penwith. This workshop will be run by Kernow Ecology on our behalf.
